16	**** Exposure is defined as If you have been within 6 feet of a COVID-19 infected person for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period starting from two days before illness onset (of for an asymptomatic individual, two days prior to the test specimen collection) until the time the individual is isolated. An infected person can spread SARS-CoV-2 starting from 2 days before they have any symptoms (or, for asymptomatic patients, 2 days before the positive specimen collection date), until they meet criteria for discontinuing home isolation.; OR if you have had direct physical contact, including unprotected contact, with bodily fluids and/or secretions (e.g. being coughed or sneezed on, sharing utensils, or drinking out of the same container); OR if you have provided care for a COVID-19 positive person without wearing personal protective equipment. Cloth face coverings are not considered personal protective equipment.
